What does your child need to bring?

BOOKING PROCEDURE

(Please note procedures within the Nursery are very different and Holiday Playscheme bookings must not be made via the Nursery nor Nursery Bookings via the Holiday Playscheme.)

- 1. Please email mohairchildcare@hotmail.co.uk to gain a provisional place, then your fees will need to be paid in advance.
 - We do not send out invoices.
- 2. Please email / send a hard copy of your booking form to the Mohair Centre by Monday 16th December.
- 3. Payment should be sent / received with your Booking Form to secure your place. This should be made by bank transfer, cheque or childcare vouchers. We do not accept cash. All Holiday Playscheme Fees must be kept separate from other Mohair Centre transactions, either within the Nursery or After School Club.
- 4. Please indicate how payment has been/ will be made on the Booking Form, detailing clearly how this will be identified in our Bank Account. Please use your child's surname to ensure that payment is easily tracked and indicate which Voucher Company has been used.
- 5. You will be required to fill in an updated registration form, if you have not attended in the last 6 months.
- 6. Jacky/ Rachel will confirm your booking on receipt of the booking form / payment via email. An email address is essential, please ensure that this is added to the Booking Form.
