## NOCN Level 3 Certificate for Forest School Leaders Level 3 (Option 1 & 2)



### OPTION 1

**MAY – SEPTEMBER WEEKEND PROGRAMME** – each student will be expected to visit a proper Forest School, led by a fully qualified Forest School Leader, during the period of training. For Level 3 there will be 9 Sessions in total

#### **7 DAYS WEEKEND TRAINING:**

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## OPTION 2

**FAST TRACK INTENSIVE TERM-TIME PROGRAMME** – for those who have worked with / are working on a Forest School Programme already. For those who are able to work intensively and work on their 6 Sessions immediately.

**NOCN Level 3 Certificate for Forest School Leaders Level 3** is designed to qualify the learner to become a Forest School Leader, able to set up and run a Forest School programme. It covers how to facilitate groups in a learner-centred way, and how to manage a Forest School site sustainably. It also covers the practical skills required of a Forest School Leader. Learners may typically be Nursery, School or College staff, Teachers, Teaching Assistants and Youth Workers. This involves 7 days of teaching, a practical part of the assessment is that you run 6 consecutive sessions with a group of children / adults followed by 2 days of practical assessment days.
