What will the children get up to?

Our morning focus will be working with the animals on the farm – rabbits, guinea pigs, chickens & ducks, sheep, goats, alpacas, ponies and pigs. From 12 noon we start to focus on the theme for the week.

Wed 24th July – Fri 26th July MYSTERY TRIP WEEK

We found that last Summer, it was nice to take the children out to different locations together. Wednesday – Hailsham Farm Market, Thursday – Abbotswood (Forest School) & Friday – Beach School. Permission to transport children in staff cars will be needed and we will send specific joining instructions for those who book for this week, including our Transport Policy.



Mon 29th July – Fri 2nd August PONIES & FISHING

Always the busiest week, last year a bit disappointing because we didn't catch one fish! However there have been fish caught since, so we hope that the fish will behave!!! The children will choose between ponies and fishing throughout the day, getting involved in related craft activities too. We learn to look after ponies; Cracker now needs a lot of TLC, Misty has managed to lose a bit of weight and Donald is enjoying being ridden. It is exciting as this is the first year that we have a larger pony, Blackjack who is a little more challenging for the older children who are now too big to sit on our Shetland ponies. We hope that the children who choose ponies will get a chance to have a pony ride, but the emphasis is on care rather than riding. Polo and his pony trap will be visiting on several days during the week, so



everybody will get a chance to have a go. Book early, as numbers will be limited to 24 children.

There will be some outside experts visiting to give the children some well chosen advice.

Booking Procedure

Please note procedures within the Nursery are very different and Holiday Playscheme bookings must not be made via the Nursery nor Nursery Bookings via the Holiday Playscheme.

1. Please email or phone to get a provisional place:

- Email / send a copy of your Booking Form to the Mohair Centre by Friday 20th July 2019
- 3. Payment should be sent / received with your Booking Form to secure your place. This should be made by bank transfer, cheque or childcare vouchers. We do not accept cash. All Holiday Playscheme Fees must be kept separate from other Mohair Centre transactions, either within the Nursery or After School Club.
- 4. Please indicate how payment has been / will be made on the Booking Form, detailing clearly how this will be identified in our Bank Account. Please use your child's surname to ensure that payment is easily tracked and indicate which Voucher Company has been used.
- 5. You will be required to fill in an updated registration form, if you have not attended since last Summer.
- 6. Jacky / Rachel will confirm your booking on receipt of the online booking form (either by Mailchimp or by filling in the Booking form attached. Please note that should you be using the post, it is wise to let us know that you are sending the booking so that we can reserve your place. In the past it has been known for postal bookings to go astray and we have no knowledge of your intention. We cannot go over 24 children.

7. CANCELLATION POLICY Places cancelled before the closing date will be refunded. (20th July)) Places cancelled after closing date (20th July) will be held in credit for future bookings. Places cancelled on the day or not taken up – full fee is payable.

We are a registered Day care facility, inspected by Ofsted. Ofsted – 0300 1231231. We have a full set of policies including a complaints procedure. Some of these policies are available in the Parent Handbook, which you will receive when your place is confirmed. Please ask if you would like to see all our policies and procedures. We work on a ratio 1:8 adults to children and safety is always most important on the farm.
