- 3. Payment should be sent / received with your Booking Form to secure your place. This should be made by bank transfer, cheque or childcare vouchers. We do not accept cash. All Holiday Playscheme Fees must be kept separate from other Mohair Centre transactions, specifically from the Nursery or After School Club.
- 4. Please indicate how payment will be made on the Booking Form, detailing clearly how this will be identified in our Bank Account. Please use your child's surname to ensure that payment is easily tracked and indicate which Voucher Company has been used.
- 5. You will receive joining instructions once your place is confirmed.
- 6. You will be required to fill in an updated registration form, if you have not attended in the last 6 months.
- 7. Rachel will confirm your booking on receipt of the booking form / payment via email. An email address is essential, please ensure that this is added to the Booking Form.
