The Three Different Levels

NOCN Level 3 Certificate for Forest School Leaders Level 3 is designed to qualify the learner to become a Forest School Leader , able to set up and run a Forest School programme. It covers how to facilitate groups in a learner-centred way, and how to manage a Forest School site sustainably. It also covers the practical skills required of a Forest School practitioner. Learners may typically be nursery, school and college staff, teachers ,teaching assistants or youth workers. This involves 7 teaching days(on line & practical), A practical part of the assessment is that you run 6 consecutive sessions with a group of children / adults followed by 2 practical assessment days. Since the Pandemic, we will not have any Classroom training, but part of the days will involve a two hourly online activity at home which will then be followed up at the Mohair Centre on a practical basis. The online

learning may be taken before the training day or on the day concerned but it will precede the practical time at the Mohair Centre. Whilst current restrictions apply we will run the group with 5 students and one trainer, this will involve creating our own bubble, but outside and all Government Guidance will be followed.

The Dates

These may be changed should somebody find one date tricky but this will be with the agreement of all five students after the first session.

DAY 1 Saturday 19th September 10-4 Mohair Centre

DAY 2 Sunday 20th September (Online Session 10-12) followed by a practical Session at the Mohair Centre 1-4

DAY 3 Saturday 26th September (Online Session 10-12) followed by a practical Session at the Mohair Centre 1-4

DAY 4 Sunday 27th September (Online Session 10-12) followed by a practical Session 1-4

DAY 5 Sunday 11th October 10-4pm Mohair Centre

DAY 6 Saturday 7th November (Online Session 10-12) followed by a practical Session at the Mohair Centre 1-4

DAY 7 Sunday 6th December (Online Session 10-12) followed by a practical Session at the Mohair Centre 1-4

It is expected that each student will run six sessions with a group of children between Day 7-8, which will be used as part of their assessment and build up their portfolio of evidence which will form part of their assessment. Your Assessor will guide you through this process.

DAY 8 Sunday 21st March Assessment Day 1 10-4 Mohair Centre

DAY 9 Sunday 28th March Assessment Day 2 10-4 Mohair Centre

NOCN Level 2 Award for Forest School Assistants Level 2 is designed to qualify a learner to become a Forest School assistant, enabling them to take a proactive role in helping a Forest School practitioner plan and deliver a Forest School programme and supporting the learners. Learners may typically be school and college staff, youth workers, parent helpers and students. Dates to be confirmed.

Cost Level 3:
