

# PARENT AGREEMENT

**We ask that you read and tick each point carefully to indicate your agreement. This Contract should be signed and returned to the Holiday Playscheme before the start of Half Term.**

Please find the arrangements we have put in place for all those attending the Holiday Playscheme during the school holiday, in order to keep everybody concerned as safe as possible. We will review the arrangements on a daily / weekly basis as we establish our new procedures. Please be patient and any feedback will be welcome. We will communicate with you with regard to any problems as soon as possible.

- **My child will not attend the Holiday Playscheme if they are ill, or show any COVID-19 symptoms; if they have a temperature, persistent cough and / or if they have lost their sense of taste & smell. If they are needing to take any medication including a Paracetamol based medicine eg Calpol or ibuprofen based medication (the exception is medication for asthma or allergy medication) it is important that they do not attend. It is important that any symptoms of COVID-19 are not masked by medication.**  
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- I will ensure the Holiday Playscheme has my up to date contact details including my work and mobile number .....
- If my child becomes ill whilst at nursery I will come and collect them immediately or plan for them to be collected by someone else immediately. Should my child develop symptoms of Covid-19 I will obtain a test as soon as I possibly can.. .....
- It is important that current self-isolation guidance is followed, should any of your household show symptoms .....
- I understand that if any one within my child's Mohair "family" group tests positive with COVID-19, you will be notified and must self-isolate for 14 days, following up-to-date guidance.  
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- We will be talking to the children about good COVID-19 hygiene practice:
  - We will make the children aware of leaving a gap between others rather than labelling a distance
  - We will ask the children to wash their hands carefully and regularly
  - Ask them to sneeze / cough into their elbows when necessary
  - adopt the 'catch it & bin it' practice throughout the day

## DROP OFF

**There will be either Jacky or Rachel at the entrance to the yard to guide you in :**

- I will drop my child off at the Mohair Centre during the following times:
  - 8am and 9.15 am .....
  - 9.15 and 10.30 .....

- Only one adult at a time will be collecting or dropping off children. Siblings can stay in the Yard using the picnic tables as you deliver your child to the Preschool Barn. The Playscheme will run outside as much as possible, but we will use the Preschool Barn as a base. this Half Term .....
- Parents/Carers will be mindful of social distance between other adults. (there is not an expectation that the children will socially distance from each other) There are red painted markers situated along Ben & Jerry's fence with some pictures of the animals should you come across a queue .....
- Parents/Carers to supervise their children at all times especially on leaving the setting and heading to the car park as all the gates will be open, we operate a one-way system in and out as you approach the yard gate .....
- Please ensure that you and your children wash their hands in the yard (sinks by the Office) or use the hand-gel provided, before proceeding to the Preschool Barn. Breakfast will be served between 8-9.15, outside if weather permits.
- We ask all that parents please drop off their children as quickly as possible, to avoid a traffic jam
- The staff will take a wobbly, tearful child from a parent if needed, but parents are asked please, not to linger. We hope that parents & children will be greeted outside the Preschool Barn and **there will be no need for parents to enter the Barn** .....
- One -way system: When leaving the setting please walk on the left-hand side by the play area close to the fence  
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**PICK UP**

Please wait at the Picnic Tables, wash your hands or use gel and we will use the Walkie-Talkie to alert the staff that your child needs to be taken to the Yard for collection. Here you will be able to collect your child. Please observe social distancing within the yard, particularly at 4.30 which is the main pick up time and 3 pm which is the Nursery's busy time.

- Parents are asked to wait and to queue again if necessary. Liz / Jacky/ Rachel (CCTV helps!) will meet you and let the staff know that you have arrived. Your child will be brought into the yard by the picnic tables. ....

**Precautions & things to bring**

- Although we will be using the outdoor environment as much as possible, resources that are used will be subject to a deep clean at the end of the day.
- Shoes that are sturdy
- Several changes of appropriate clothing – there will be lots of water / mud!
- Water-proofs and wellies
- A warm jumper, hoody when the weather is cold – several layers are advised
- A named water bottle
- My child will be wearing clean clothes every day
