

FEES

We cannot accept any children without correct, up to date registration details nor payment in advance. You will shortly receive an invoice for the Summer Playscheme. Fees are payable in advance. We accept Childcare Vouchers. Should you wish to pay in instalments please let us know. 50% of your invoice will need to be paid in advance, a further 50% by Week 4 10th August. Nursery fees will be invoiced in the normal way.

Week 1 - Small Animals Monday 26th - Friday 30th July







We will be concentrating on the small animals all week, adopting a small animal. This will involve a Pet Show, learning about care, grooming, handling and routine feeding. The small animals will be spick-and-span. There will be some small animal crafts to go with the sessions. Lots of fun

Week 2 – Ponies → Fishing (Pond-dipping) Monday 2nd – Friday 6th August

We spend the whole week focusing on Ponies & Fishing / Pond-dipping. We have still not solved our problems with our pond but we will have a go at fishing, those that want to, try and catch these illusive fish (you never know!). Failing that, we will be pond-dipping. Lots of 'Fish-related' crafts will be on offer; clay, fish mobiles & paper-mache. The Pony Group will be focusing on pony care; grooming, cleaning tack and there may be an opportunity to sit on one of our ponies; Blackjack, Hamish, Donald or Misty. There will be lots of pony related crafts as well.
