Week 1 – Small Animals Monday 25th – Friday 29th July







We will be concentrating on the small animals all week, adopting a small animal. This will involve a Pet Show, learning about care, grooming, handling and routine feeding. The small animals will be spick-and-span. There will be some small animal crafts to go with the sessions. Lots of fun

Week 2 – Young Enterprise Week Monday 1st – Friday 5th August





A fun week, where the children will be working in groups, to create a product, organise production, marketing together and finally set up their own stall to sell their product for their chosen charity at pick-up times both in Out of School and the Nursery. We will be advertising our selling times to Nursery as well so that the Nursery can visit the stalls. The Groups will be supported by an adult and younger / older children will work together.

Week 3 – Forest School Week Monday 8th – Friday 12th August



Although we will be visiting Forest School every day, during the Summer the whole week will be focused on Forest School. Apart from feeding the animals in the morning we will be spending all our time at Forest School, practising our Forest School Skills and enjoying a challenge or two; fire-lighting, cooking, den-building, Forest School Crafts, music-making, tool use such as whittling, exploring the natural environment, learning to use knots and much, much more.

Week 4 Ponies & Fishing (Pond-dipping) Monday 2nd – Friday 6th August

We spend the whole week focusing on Ponies & Fishing / Pond-dipping. We have still not solved our problems with our pond but we will have a go at fishing, those that want to, try and catch these illusive fish (you never know!). Failing that, we will be pond-dipping. Lots of 'Fish-related' crafts will be on offer; clay, fish mobiles & paper-mache. There will be lots of pony related crafts as well.
